However, in line with the global trend on the anti-corruption, Malaysian's laws and regulations have been becoming more severe. Among others, Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act amended in 2018 and the Guidelines on Adequate Procedures issued in 2018 are remarkable.

As a DENSO group company, the Company must continuously monitor such environmental change and improve and update our policy and/or behavior.

The Company strictly prohibits all form of corruptions and encourages our managements and employees to act positively to prevent any corruption in the Company's business operations, directly or indirectly through third parties, which includes (i) providing, offering or promising bribe, (ii) soliciting, demanding, receiving or promising bribe, (iii) providing false claim, (iv) abuse of entrusted power, (v) conflict of interest or (vi) any other acts which are considered corruption practices. Accordingly, the Company requests your understanding and cooperation on our sustainable business with ethical manners and in compliance with anti-corruption laws and regulations in carrying out your contractual obligations with the Company.
