

DENSO's Routine/Preventive Medical Plan Coverage Summary:

Well Child Care (including immunizations)¹

- Age and frequency restrictions:
 - 6 visits per calendar year through age 2
 - 2 visits per year age 3 to 4
 - 1 visit per year age 4 through 15
- If you bring up symptoms/problems or if the doctor discovers a problem during the physical, he/she may charge you for a diagnostic service which will be applied toward deductible/coinsurance and/or copay.

Adult Physical¹

- Age restrictions: 16 and older
- If you bring up symptoms/problems or if the doctor discovers a problem during the physical, he/she may charge you for a diagnostic service which will be applied toward deductible/coinsurance and/or copay.
- For men, an annual **PSA test or Digital Rectal Exam** will also be covered as preventive.

Well-Woman Exam¹

- Age restrictions: none
- Frequency restrictions: one per calendar year, in addition to Adult Physical (additional will apply to deductible/coinsurance and/or copay)
- If you bring up symptoms/problems or if the doctor discovers a problem during the physical, he/she may charge you for a diagnostic service which will be applied toward deductible/coinsurance and/or copay.

Adult Immunizations¹

- Age restrictions: 16 and older
- Restrictions: none--100% paid under preventive benefits when billed with a routine screening diagnosis

Bone Density Examination (Osteoporosis screening)

- Age restrictions: 65 or older women (or risk greater to or equal to 65)
- Frequency restrictions: one per calendar year

Mammogram

- Age restrictions: none
- All preventive/routine mammograms are covered at 100% - digital (including 3D) or film imaging
- If you have no symptoms but a problem is found, the initial mammogram will still be billed as preventive/routine. If an additional mammogram is ordered to do additional films or further diagnostics it will be billed as diagnostic, and deductible/coinsurance and/or copay would be applied.
- If you are given an ultrasound instead of a mammogram (either by your choice or the doctor's choice), it will be applied toward deductible/coinsurance and/or copay. It is not covered as preventive like a mammogram.

Colonoscopy

- Age restrictions: none
- All preventive/routine colonoscopies are covered at 100%.

Dental Exams

- Age restrictions: none
- If you are enrolled in the Dental Core or Dental Plus plans through Delta Dental, the first two (2) exams each calendar year will be paid at 100%² whether you're having problems or not. If you use these two exams for treatment of problems, your preventive exams for that year will be applied to the deductible/coinsurance. There is no requirement that the two exams be 6 months apart.
