

Check Provider Participation before your Checkup

Even if you have a regular dentist, make sure your provider is still innetwork before your visit to avoid getting stuck with an unexpected bill.

Use Delta Dental's "Find a Provider" tool on the <u>website</u> or app (follow QR code on left) to confirm your provider participates in <u>Delta Dental</u> Premier or Delta Dental PPO. See example below:
